Tips for your Museum Field Trip

Before you arrive:

- Nametags- please have all students, teachers and chaperones wear nametags. This helps us to interact more easily with everyone.
- Divide the class(es) into **5 groups** (maximum 8 students per group). Please plan to have one chaperone for every group.
- To make the tour a rewarding experience we ask that all electronics be left in backpacks.
- Chaperone requirements- adult chaperones are an important component of the museum tour. We will need the chaperones to monitor the children's behavior, ensure that the displays in the museum are not touched, and keep children on task and moving from one station to the next as required.
- We have many outdoor exhibits and garden beds. Please talk to your students ahead of time about respectful interactions with the property. (Staying on the paths to protect the plants and artifacts.)
- The school tour takes approximately 1 ½ hours. Please allow additional time to organize children on arrival and departure so that you have ample time to return to the school.
