### **Visitor Information Counsellor Summer 2023**

Full & Part-Time Positions \$17.50 hr

Positions will start in mid May and end late August.

Provide information to visitors on the various attractions, events, businesses, and activities in the region. Help with the collection of statistical information on tourists in the region. Assist newcomers to the community with information of services in the region. Promote responsible use of the region's environment by visitors.

Assist with the operation of our summer Night Market which is primarily a farmer\food market held on a weekly basis. During the market, you may assist the programs manager with setup/takedown of the market. Our market is an important venue for local farmers, food vendors and artisans. The market attracts between 1000 and 2000 people and is popular amongst the community.

Provide interpretive tours of on-site heritage attractions, including acting as an historical person. Assist with youth and adult programs. Assist with Facebook & Twitter accounts, work on our database of heritage and community information.

The ideal candidate will be interested in human and natural history. They will have a good knowledge of the Sooke region. Be comfortable communicating with people in person. A second language would be an asset.

We have three positions available for full time and part-time starting in May and late June.

Please note, the federal government provides the funding for this position. You must meet the following criteria to be eligible to apply:

To be eligible, youth must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment; and,
- have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
